## Meeting Minutes

**Tuesday, September 27, 2016 6:00 p.m.**

Meeting minutes' approval for September 8, 2016. Motion Sinnwell, Second Johnson to approve. Ayes: 4 Nays:0.

Commissioner D. Dietz joined the meeting at 6:06 p.m.

Discussion was held regarding parks flood damage. Docks will need a lot of work. Commissioner D. Dietz will get quotes on all damage. Dwight will be contacting Commissioner D. Dietz in regards to trees hung up by Dam. Commissioner D. Dietz also noted that the safety cable needs hung back up.

Discussion was held regarding Lakeshore Park trail maintenance. Commissioner D. Dietz provided an update and is still working with vendors. Commissioner Roberts will have a local contractor, Triple S Seeding contact Commissioner D. Dietz to discuss further. Will follow-up with the possibility of grants and assistance from Chickasaw County Conservation. Commissioner Johnson will follow-up with Trees Forever.
