Meeting Minutes

Thursday, July 21, 2016 5:30 p.m.

Meeting called to order at 5:37 p.m. at Gateway to Northeast Iowa Welcome Center.

Meeting minutes approved for June 16, 2016.

Commissioner Jung provided an update for Parks Maintenance. Extra gravel has been placed. We are looking at a 2004 Chevrolet pickup for purchase. Only one key available for the toilet paper dispenser.

Commissioner Jung advised that the Camp Host had no updates. Commissioner D. Dietz discussed the light by campsite 39 and possible safety concerns. Commissioner Johnson will be looking into the matter to report back.

Campground 'Rules/Events/Local amenities' brochure tabled due to Commissioner Sinnwell absent.

The Commissioners present all agreed to the following into regards of County camp weeks: Floyd County-September 11-17; Chickasaw County- September 18-24; and all of October will be for all IOWA license plates. We will offer Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday Free if you pay for the following Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

Commissioner Johnson reported that Johnson Electric will have site 11 electrical completed by the end of the month.

Commissioner D. Dietz advised that he has pipe to try to fix the Skate Park fence. If it works he will replace it all the last week of July.

The commissioners present all signed up for the next three months of on-call schedule.

Commissioner Johnson provided an update on the Cedar Lake Block Party set for August 13, 2016. It will be a potluck with mad rites and hot dogs provided. Bean bag toss, sand volleyball, and pop dive to name a few events. The events will take place from 11-3pm.
