

Nashua City Council Meeting

Welcome Center

June 29, 2017 6:00PM

The Nashua City Council met in a special meeting June 29, 2017 at 6:01pm. Mayor Angelina Dietz presided with Council members Rolland Cagley, Brenda Roberts, Tom Johnson, Ryan Jung and Kyle Lane present.

The following employees were in attendance: City Attorney David Skilton, Temporary City Clerk Becky Neal and Utility Clerk Beth Henningsen. 22 guests were in attendance.

Motion Jung, seconded by Lane to approve agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held for a plan on budget. Dietz explained that it was going to be a rough year as we will not be getting any new money. Dietz told Council that they need to come up with some ideas on how to cut the budget. Jung asked where the Watson Fund is and if we could use that. Neal explained that the City is only allowed to use the interest and the rest is tied up into CD's. Neal said that only the Fire Department was allowed to use their portion of the Watson Funds and the City and Library were to only use the interest. Neal went on to say that after moving money into the correct funds that she had the Water and Sewer in the positive along with debt service, however the general fund was still in the negative. Jung suggested that each Department take a 10 percent cut. Neal agreed saying that could work. Neal said she would work on a new budget and take off 10 percent across the board and also the 3 percent wage increase. She will then present the new budget to Council at the next meeting.

Motion Lane, seconded by Jung to override Resolution/Ordinance of Chapter 24, An Ordinance regarding City Administrator for the City of Nashua, Iowa which was originally adopted June 5th, 2017 and vetoed by the Mayor on June 8th, 2017. Roll Call: Cagley: No, Roberts: Yes, Johnson: No, Jung: Yes, Lane: Yes. Motion Overturned

Motion Jung, seconded by Lane to hire for a Full Time City Clerk and a part time Deputy Clerk. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion was held for the grant at location Hwy 346. It was agreed upon to extend the grant until November 1st, 2017 and that letters were to be sent out to the businesses asking them to put in sidewalks.

Motion Lane, seconded by Jung to temporarily make the Utility Clerk full time with a \$1.00 increase in wage until September 1, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion Lane, seconded by Johnson to approve a movie license for the park by Swank Motion Pictures. The cost was paid for by Johnson Electric. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion Jung, seconded by Roberts to adjourn the meeting at 7:59PM. Motion carried unanimously.
